

RESEARCH PROGRAM 2024 GRANT ROUND

APPLICATIONS NOW OPEN

Diabetes Australia is dedicated to reducing the incidence and impact of diabetes on people, health systems and society. We work with people living with or at risk of diabetes, their families and carers, health professionals, researchers, funders, other diabetes organisations and the community to positively change people's lives.

In 2024, Diabetes Australia plans to provide vital funding for diabetes research projects across Australia, including:

- Two \$150,000 Millennium Awards: one for type 1 diabetes and one for type 2 diabetes
- One \$150,000 Charles Campbell Coghlan OAM Emerging Researcher Award for an early to mid-career researcher
- 15 General Grants, up to \$60,000 per grant.

Applications for the 2024 Grant Round are now open. Research projects into any aspect of diabetes management or prevention will be considered. Diabetes Australia encourages applications that focus on:

- Self-monitoring and self-management education and support in diabetes
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people and diabetes
- Behavioural and psychological research in diabetes.
