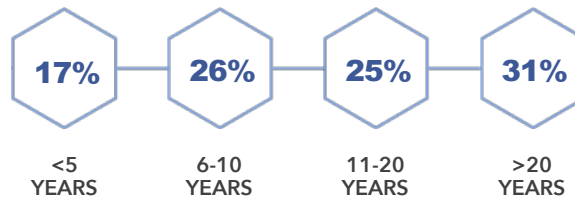
WHO RESPONDED?

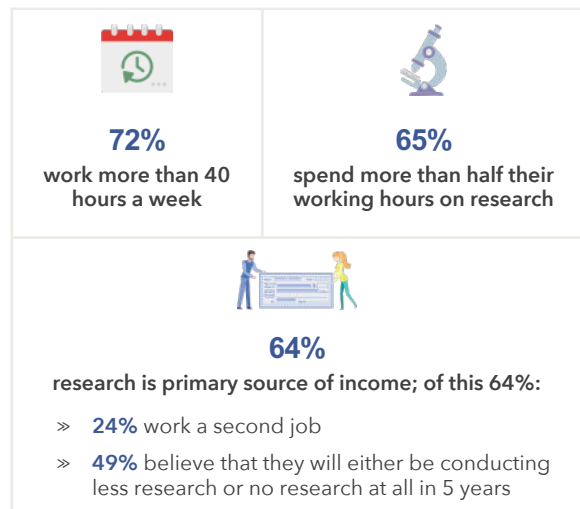
RECRUITING

- PhD students and post doctoral researchers are difficult to recruit

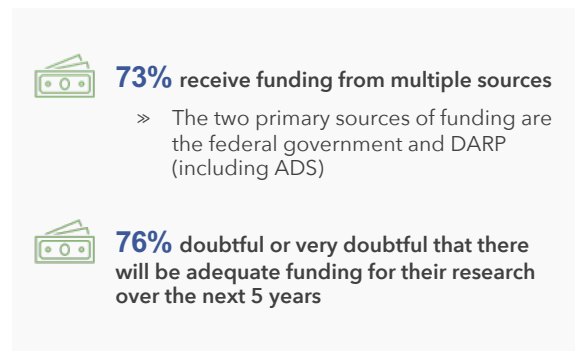
RESEARCH APPROVAL PROCESSES

- 82% find negotiating research contracts between institutions moderately or extremely burdensome

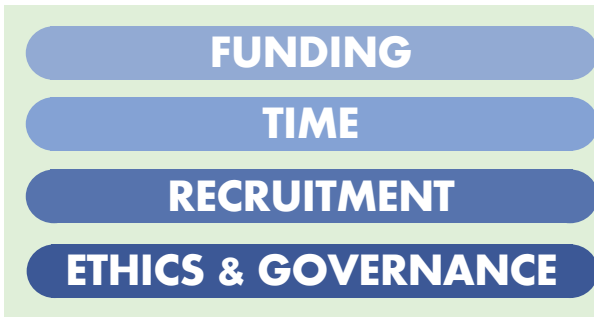
